The Body of Christ! =THE CHURCH

The English word “**Church**” etymologically signifies a building, called the house of God. No such sense is attached to “**ekklesia**” in the New Testament. In the four instances where “**oikos, house,**” refers to the Church (I Timothy 3:15; Hebrews 3:2; I Peter 2:5; 4:17) the usage is metaphorical, meaning the household or family of God.

Let me say it another way. The Church is a divine institution, founded by Christ and composed of true believers. It is the community of redemption, constituting a new and unique race, united by the Spirit in the blood-ties of Calvary. Its internal function is to be a matrix of worship, nurture, fellowship and service. Its external mission is to represent God in Christ to the whole world, through holiness of life and the proclamation of the gospel to every creature.

Over the next couple of months we have some opportunities to be “**the Church**” in some exciting ways. Some are within the Council Bluffs community and some are with the idea of blessing and equipping “**the Church**” around the world. We will be sharing these with you over the next couple of weeks.

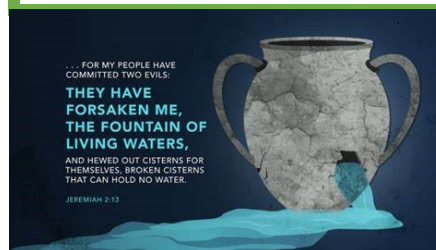
